Path to Graduation

- English 4 credits (Eng9, Eng10, Eng11, Elective)
 - Math 4 credits (must earn at least Alg II)
 - Science 3 credits (Bio, Physical Sci, Elective Science)
 - Social Studies 3 credits (World History, US History, Government and Economics)
 - Physical Ed $\frac{1}{4}$ credit + $\frac{1}{4}$ credit **OR** PE Waiver*
 - Health 0.5 credit
 - Creative/
Performing Arts One full credit (Chorus, Band, Fine Art)
 - Electives At least 4 credits (Foreign Language, Business, Technology, Family/Consumer Science)
- *add 0.5 elective credit if utilizing PE Waiver

Diploma with Honors

- Requirements...meet 7 of the 8 below:
 - 4 English credits
 - 4 Math credits
 - 4 Science credits (including Chemistry and Physics)
 - 4 Social Studies credits
 - 1 Fine/Performing Art credit
 - 3 credits of Same Foreign Language OR 2/2 credits of different Foreign Languages.
 - 3.5+ UNweighted GPA
 - 27+ ACT OR 1210+(Reading & Math) SAT*
 - *SAT requirement may change!

Four Core Classes:

- **To override a teacher's recommendation, see your Guidance Counselor to begin the process.**

Electives.....

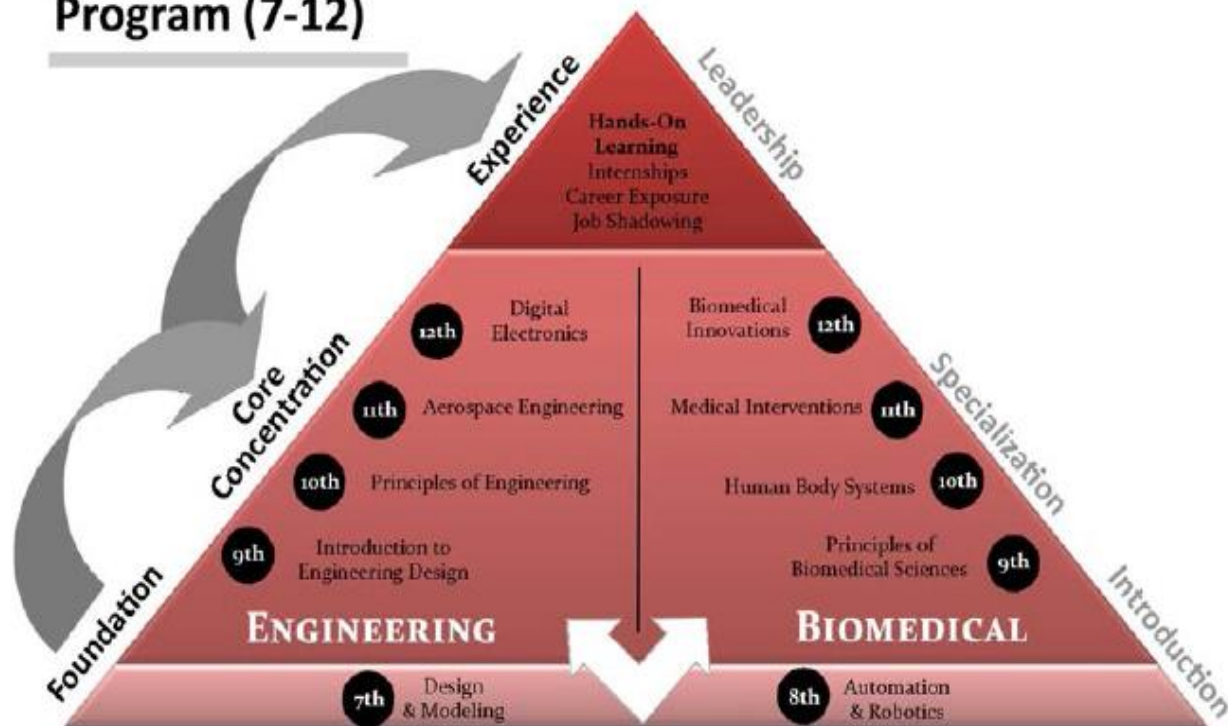
- Need to take two (2) elective classes to complete a 6 period day
 - Electives are:
 - Band (Audition/Approval of Instructor required)
 - Choir (Audition/Approval of Instructor required)
 - Fine Arts (Acting I, Fine Art I and a number of courses that require Fine Art as a prerequisite)
 - Computer Science (including a new AP Computer Science)
 - Foreign Language
 - Additional Health and PE courses
 - STEAM² courses
 - New Butler Tech Programs/courses
 - Business courses (Financial Literacy & Planning, Sports/Ent. Marketing)
 - Family and Consumer Science (multiple courses)

Athletes


- If you are participating in a Lakota West Sport you **MUST** have 5 solid classes:
 - Solid classes are any class other than PE.
 - Solid classes are semester classes earning .5 credit.
- Eligibility
 - **IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE, YOU MUST HAVE BEEN ENROLLED IN AND PASSED 5 SOLID CLASSES THE PRECEDING GRADING PERIOD AND BE PASSING 5 SOLID CLASSES DURING THE CURRENT QUARTER/ SEMESTER. IT IS ADVISED THAT YOU MAINTAIN 5 SOLID CLASSES THE ENTIRE ACADEMIC SCHOOL YEAR. SOLIDS ARE HALF CREDIT (.5) EARNING SEMESTER COURSES – ONE PE CLASS IS NOT CONSIDERED A SOLID.**
 - ****Talk to your guidance counselor for clarification.
 - It is advised to have 5 solids the entire school year (6 solids is preferred).
- NCAA eligibility center
 - If you anticipate participating in college sports you should be registering with the NCAA. ****Talk to your guidance counselor

How to register!

- All registration will be completed through the student's account in Home Access Center (HAC).
- Registration will begin **Jan. 27th – Feb. 6th**.
- Teachers will be making recommendation beginning **Jan. 17th**. Students should speak with their current teachers.
- You need to know your HAC log-in ID and password, please contact the guidance office.
- **If you do not select your classes, someone will select them for you. Signed verification sheet due by February 24th back to Guidance Office!**
